


My Dilemma: Traditional Technique vs. Reality

Executable over several work sessions


Use Acrylics

Base Color Application



- Sponge Application
- Even coverage unnecessary
- 5 minute rule

Adding Color Variation



- Use initial color as mixing base
- Dry Sponge application
- Variation is modeler's preference (Rust and White)
- Cold Feet?

Tone Down Contrasts



- Black goes with everything!!
- So does white!

Top Coat & Mortar Wash


